

## Legislative and Games Committee Meeting Minutes

<u>Call to Order</u>: Margaret Morton called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m.

- I. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>: On a motion made by Ms. Morton, seconded by Mr. Mattison, the minutes of the February 20, 2013 Legislative and Games Committee Meeting were unanimously approved.
- II. <u>Sales Performance</u>:

Total all games sales for March 2013 were \$103.3 million. As of March 31, 2013, transfers to the General Fund were \$229.5 million.

CT games through March 31, 2013 are on budget. Multi-state games through March 31, 2013 are up 10.6% compared to budget.

Instant ticket sales remained strong, with \$61.6 million in sales for the month of March. Play3 and Play4 games are holding steady at \$20.9 million for the month of March. Classic Lotto sales for March 2013 were \$1.8 million. Cash5 sales for March 2013 were \$2.8 million. Powerball sales for the month of March reached \$11.8 million. Mega Millions sales for March were \$1.7 million. Lucky for Life sales for March 2013 were \$2.5 million. III. <u>Executive Session</u>

On a motion made by Ms. Morton, seconded by Mr. Mattison, and unanimously approved, the Committee moved to Executive Session at 1:25 p.m. Ms. Morton invited: Ms. Noble, and Ms. Patterson to stay for the Executive Session relating to the Review of New Game and Promotional Initiatives and Discussion Concerning Selection of Site.

Ms. Noble and Ms. Patterson left Executive Session at approximately 1:55 p.m.

The Committee reconvened in regular session at approximately 2:05 p.m. No actions or votes were taken during Executive Session.
