

# Legislative and Games Committee Meeting Minutes

<u>Call to Order:</u> Ms. Morton called the meeting to order at 2:35 p.m.

### I. Approval of Minutes:

On a motion made by Mr. Mattison and seconded by Mr. Morgan, the Minutes of the May 21, 2013 Legislative and Games Committee Meeting were unanimously approved.

#### II. Sales Performance:

Total all games sales for May 2013 were an estimated \$111.3 million. As of May 31, 2013, transfers to the General Fund were approximately \$278.8 million.

CT games through May 31, 2013 are slightly above budget. Multi-state games through May 2013 are up 17.1% compared to budget.

Instant ticket sales remained strong, with \$60.5 million in sales for the month of May. Play3 and Play4 games were \$21.8 million for the month of May. Classic Lotto sales for May 2013 are holding steady at \$1.8 million. Cash5 sales for May 2013 were \$2.8 million. Powerball sales for the month of May reached \$18.4 million. Mega Millions sales for May were \$3.0 million. Mega Millions has been hit 14 times this fiscal year, at an average of \$60 million per payout. Lucky for Life is performing as expected. Plans are underway for changes to this game. Sales for May 2013 were \$2.4 million.

Super Draw 7 will run from April 28 – July 3, 2013 with the drawing taking place on July  $4^{th}$ , 2013. The ticket price is \$10 with 275,000 tickets available.
