I. Welcome and Call to Order:

Ms. Morton called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m.

II. Review and Possible Action: Millionaire for Life Game Rules:

Ms. Durso provided an overview of the Millionaire for Life game, noting that it is a new \$5 multi-jurisdictional draw game set to launch early 2026, operated under a joint agreement among participating lotteries, replacing Lucky for Life. Drawings will occur seven days a week at 10:15 p.m. Central, with sales closing at 9:15 p.m. There are nine prize levels, including two lifetime annuity prizes; the game will be operated under the Multi State Lottery Association (MUSL) with standard security, validation, and prize claim rules.

On a motion by Mr. Dalena, seconded by Ms. Morton, and unanimously approved, it was:

Resolved, that after review and due consideration, the Legislative and Games Committee hereby approves the Millionaire for Life game rules and the corresponding Connecticut Amendment as presented, and authorizes the CLC team to make conforming adjustments, if required by final national game specifications, prior to launch.
