The claims center and visitor entrance is at the four way stop at the intersection of Enterprise and Sterling Drives.

The new Wallingford claims center will be open Monday through Friday from 8:30AM to 4:30PM, except state holidays.

All valid claims that reached their 180 calendar day expiration on August 22, 2023 through August 31, 2023 will be honored if presented in-person at the Wallingford claims center <u>no later than September 29, 2023</u>.
